


#### COVID-19 Virus Tracking

 in cases.




**US Daily New Cases**


### U.S. Testing

 The average number of patients hospitalized fell to about 119,000 (a decrease of 7.5% from the prior week) and the biggest one-week percentage drop since Aug.






#### **US Vaccines Administered**

Western Region & Northeast, South, Midwest Regions






Cases

- Arizona had the highest 7-day new case average in the country.
- Although there has been a significant decline in new cases, Los Angeles officials expect it to be 10-11 more weeks before they reach pre-surge levels again.






#### Feeder Markets: Southeast – New Cases


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#### Western Mountain Destinations – New

Cases


- Blaine County (Sun Valley) saw its new cases go from an average of 8/day on Jan. 10 to 20/day on Jan. 24.
- During this same time frame, Routt County (Steamboat) went from an average of 13/day to an average of 25/day.

Cases


- 7 of 11 mountain communities are seeing a downward trend in cases.

- Between Jan. 5-18, Teton County had its largest 2-week case increase so far, adding 540 new cases.






#### Southeast Destinations – New Cases

• Sevier County (Gatlinburg/Pig eon Forge) saw a 35% decrease in new daily cases over the last 14 days accompanied by a 26% decline in the number of hospitalized patients.



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


### California

- 54 of the 58 counties still fall under the most restrictive purple tier of reopening.




 Daily new cases are declining in Florida, but the state is reported to have the second-highest number of variant cases in the country.
